2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "**Financial Plan 2016-2020, Bylaw No. 907, 2016**".

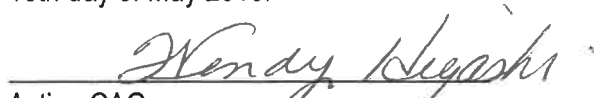

 Statement of Objectives and Policies  
 Schedule B of Bylaw No. 888a, 2015

In accordance with Section 165 (3.1) of the Community Charter, the City of Greenwood is required to include in the Five Year Financial Plan, objectives and policies regarding each of the following:

1. The portion of total revenue that comes from each of the funding sources described in Section 165 (7) of the Community Charter,
2. The distribution of property taxes among property classes, and
3. The use of permissive tax exemptions.

**FUNDING SOURCES**

Table 1 shows the portion of total revenue proposed to be raised from each funding source in 2015.

Government grants form the largest portion of the planned revenue.  
 Property & Parcel taxes form the 2nd largest portion.  
 User Fees & Charges and Other Sources of revenue form the remaining portion of the planned revenue.

**Objective**

Over the next 5 years, the City will increase the portion of revenue that is received from user fees & charges by 2% over the next 5 years to cover increased operational costs.

The City will evaluate their own property needs to determine what City-owned properties may be released for public sale at a later date.

**Policies**

The City will review user fee levels to ensure they are adequately meeting both capital and delivery costs of the services that are charging user fees. A Bylaw of Fees and Charges has been drafted to enable the collection of fees for various services rendered by the City of Greenwood.

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**Distribution of Property Tax Rates**

Table 2 outlines the distribution of the property taxes among the property classes.

**Objective**

Over the next 5 years, to maintain the % of Total Property Taxation the same for each property class.

**Policies**

Encourage economic development initiatives that will bring more business to Greenwood and the surrounding area. New businesses in Greenwood will help off set the tax burden of current businesses. Businesses in the area will provide employment for the residents of Greenwood.

**Permissive Tax Exemptions**

The City has no policy on permissive tax exemptions.

**Objective**

Over the next three years, the City will develop a policy on permissive tax exemptions.

**Policy**

The City will obtain polices from other communities and use them as models to develop a Greenwood policy.
