WATER REGULATION AMENDMENT BYLAW
(A Bylaw to eliminate early payment discount and prorate of fees)

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Greenwood, in open meeting assembled,
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Citation**

This Bylaw may be cited as “Water Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 848,
2010;

2. **Repeals**

The following Section 6(3), 6(7) of Bylaw No. 687 is repealed:

“6(3) User rates paid by the close of business on the last working day
in February, shall be subject to a 10% discount, and user rates not paid by
the deadline date established as the first working day after July 1st in each year,
shall be subject to a 10% penalty. A notice stating that such rates are due
shall be mailed during the month of January in each year, and every such
notice shall state the amount of the discount and the date by which the account
is required to be paid in order for the discount to apply.”

“6(7) A rebate may be allowed if a consumer gives notice in writing in
advance that he is leaving the premises. Such rebate shall be limited to
the remaining full monthly rates which have been paid.”

and the following is substituted:

6(3) “User rates not paid by the deadline date established as the first
working day after July 1st in each year, shall be subject to a
10% penalty. A notice stating that such rates are due shall be
mailed during the month of January in each year, and every such
notice shall state user rates not paid by the deadline date
established as the first working day after July 1st in each year,
shall be subject to a 10% penalty.”




