Berkeley Springs Sign Proposal

- Councillor Noll presented options for Berkeley Springs Sign Proposal
- Proposed sign size is 5' x 11'
- Approximate cost per sign will run approximately \$1,000.00
- \$300 to print/\$300 for Raw Material for Kiosk, labour etc.
- Council wish to have the Berkeley Sign done before the award ceremony on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2012.
- Councillor Noll will get more sign designs and structure information together for a later addendum to Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> April regular council meeting.
- Council wish to have the Berkeley Springs Sign out by the Tunnel. Staff to look into permits etc.
- Look at possibility of moving the Smelter Signage (North end of Town) to tunnel area on the right side of highway by the City Information Signage. Staff to check records on permit from highways to move smelter sign.

Recreation Grant – for Multipurpose Recreation Facility Councillor Ashton asked whether the City should be contacting stakeholders asking for financial contribution towards the City's portion of the grant commitment of \$65,800.00. Council agree with Councillor Ashton and that staff be directed to write letter to community groups and corporate sponsors asking if they can contribute funding towards the City share of the grant.
