MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

(a) Report on the results of Opinion poll
Administrator reported the following summary of the results of the by-election opinion poll:
Number of people voting yes – 84 (included 2 votes received by email)
Number of people voting no - 77 (included 2 votes received by email)
The poll was prepared by Administrator and the Deputy Clerk. It was reviewed by the Mayor. The sheets were counted twice by two separate people. The totals agreed. The returned sheets were shredded after the results were counted.

(b) By Election (014-11)
